### **STORAGE**

Lupranate® 234 Isocyanate is supplied in tank trucks and drums. Once a container has been opened, care should be taken to exclude moisture. The most favorable temperature for storage of this product is 20-35°C. If stored at higher temperatures, or if moisture is not excluded, an undesirable increase in viscosity will occur. Below 0°C crystallization may occur. The shelf life of Lupranate® 234 Isocyanate is six months if the temperature is maintained at 20-35°C and moisture is excluded.
